Super League Terms & Conditions

How does the upfront payment work? Each player is required to pay the \$85 rego fee and the season playing fee. The season playing fee is calculated by the number of weeks in the season multiplied by the cost of each week. For Example – 18-week season x \$22 a night = \$396 per player per team. Rego fee is not included in the season playing fee. Payment is required online prior to the commencement of the season or by direct debit on a weekly or fortnightly basis.

How do I know what to pay if I have more than two players in my team?

If you have more than two players, you will be charged based on the rotational roster set by teams at the start of the season. A final reconciliation will be done at the end of each season and invoices adjusted to reflect byes, wet weather, forfeits etc. If your team is in credit at the end of this audit you will receive the option of a refund or credit.

Will I have to pay for Finals?

Yes, you will be required to pay for Final matches, players will have to pay at the venue before play.

Will I be charged for Rained out matches?

If the entire night is cancelled, you will not be charged for that week's match. If teams have commenced playing & balls have been issued, no credits will be issued if the match is subsequently rained out. A final reconciliation will be done at the end of each season and invoices adjusted to reflect byes, wet weather, forfeits etc. If your team is in credit at the end of this audit you will receive the option of a refund or credit.

Will I be charged for Byes?

You will not be charged for byes. A final reconciliation will be done at the end of each season and invoices adjusted to reflect byes, wet weather, forfeits etc. If your team is in credit at the end of this audit you will receive your choice of a refund or credit.

Will I be charged a Registration Fee?

Yes, you will be required to pay the \$85 for Tennis Brisbane registration every season that you play. This covers the cost to administer the competition and the Finals presentation.

What if I can't play?

If you are unable to play, then you will be required to find a fill-in replacement player for yourself. If you are in a team of 3 or more you can simply ask your team mate to play for you. If you are in a team of 2 you can post a request on our adult programs closed Facebook page, ask a friend or colleague to play for you or you can call our office and we can provide you with a list of players and contact details that may be available to play.

Will your staff find a fill-in for me?

No, it is your responsibility to ensure your team has sufficient players present for each match. We will assist you to the best of our ability however if you are unable to field a team, a "forfeit fee" will be added to your team's season fees.

What is the forfeit fee?

The forfeit fee is the total match fee for both teams. It is a fee avoidable by organizing a fill-in ahead of time.

Will Fill In's be charged?

It is up to you to arrange payment from a fill in if they play for you. You can do this in either of the following ways:

- 1. Ask your fill in to pay online the weekly fee and we will credit this to your invoice or
- 2. Collect the playing fee direct from the fill in or
- 3. Cover the cost of the fill in to play for you & avoid a forfeit fee.

Do I need to be a club member?

Yes, all players must be current financial members of Pure Tennis Ferny Hills to represent our club in Super League
